

White Wines

Rosé

Château Beaulieu, Coteaux d'Aix-en-Provence, France 2022 45.00

The rosé is brilliantly clear salmon pink in colour. Abound with redcurrant and wild strawberry perfumes that develop into juicy white peach and pear notes. On the palate, fresh acidity is balanced beautifully with the alcohol and gives an elegant mouth feel and refreshing length.

Light and crisp

Famille Perrin, Luberon Blanc, France 2023 38.00

This wine has delicate notes of white flowers and citrus fruit on the nose. The palate is well-balanced with a racy acidity that perfectly complements the stone fruit and saline flavours, which linger on the finish.

Domaine Felines Jourdan, Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France 2023 39.00

Spicy and floral nose, distinctive with echoes of gunflint, fennel, oyster shell, pebbles and a hint of honey. Unbeatable match with shellfish, grilled fish and asparagus. Stunning.

Kumpf & Meyer, Y'a Plus Qu's!, Sylvaner/Auxerrois, Alsace, France (organic) 2021 53.00

Real 'vin de soif' with generous fruit such as pear, orange, mango and floral hints followed by a lengthy finish. Unfiltered, unfinned and no SO2 added. Perfect wine for a sundowner.

Meyer-Fonné, Pinot blanc, Vieilles Vignes, Alsace, France (biodynamic) 2022 52.00

This biodynamic wine acts like Pinot Gris on the nose - rich, oily apricot and pear fruit - but the touch of white pepper and taste of freshly squeezed oranges is classic Pinot Blanc. The palate is rich and honeyed, but dry with a smokey side and a touch of citrus.

Domaine de Menard, 'Cuvee Marine', Pays de Gascogne, France (organic) 2020 36.00

Very aromatic, with scents of white flowers, pear drop, and honey suckle. The palate is crisp and gives an instant impression of freshness. Exuberant flavours of aniseed, exotic fruit, pear, and menthol hints.

'La Dilettante', Pierre et Catherine Breton, Vouvray, Loire, France (organic) (biodynamic) 2023 60.00

100% Chenin Blanc from 40-year-old vines grown on sandy-silica-clay soils. This wine is matured in 600L old oak demi-muids for 8 months and given a rough filtration off the gross lees by racking, with no fining. Certified organic and biodynamic.

Ponte Pietra, Trebbiano/Garganega, Veneto, Italy 2023 34.00

This wine is pale lemon in color, with aromas of almond blossom and green apples. It is lively and crisp on the palate with a touch of marzipan and honey from the Garganega. It displays citrus flavors on the finish.

Pinot Grigio, Cantina San Simone, Friuli Venezia-Giulia, Italy 2023 39.00

Delicious crisp acidity with lime and pear flavors. The fruit intensity balanced with freshness make this an outstanding example of Friuli.

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Cantina Mesa, Mesa 'Primo Bianco' Vermentino de Sardegna, Sardinia, Italy 2017/2019 44.00
Clear pale straw in colour. Intense and delicate bouquet with emphatic fragrances of citrus and bergamot, floral essences of roses and pungent rosemary. The palate is crisp, dry and savory with a lovely delicacy and a finesse that continues throughout the long finish.

Cantina Tollo, Trebbiano D'Abruzzo 'Biologico', Abruzzo, Italy (organic) 2020 40.00
Pale and unfiltered, this wine has a fragrance that is fruity, with subtle floral and mineral notes. While the flavour is medium-bodied, it is delicate and savoury with an almondy finish. Certified organic.

Albarino, Bodega Castro Martin, Valle de Salnés, Rias Baixas, Spain 2022 52.00
This wine is sleek, racy and thrilling to drink. This Albarino comes from northwest Spain and is zippy, delicious and so easy to drink.

Duque de Viseu, Dão Branco, Carvalhais, Portugal 2022 38.00
This Portuguese wine shows elegant and intense aromas of fresh citrus and stone fruits and some minerality, which gives it great freshness and complexity. The palate is elegant and balanced, with fresh fruit flavours and crisp acidity lasting for a long time on the finish.

Von Winning, Sauvignon II, Deidesheim, Germany (organic) 2022 51.00
On the nose grapefruit, cranberries, apple and lime with hints of herbs and elderberry. On the palate crispy but not too much, full-bodied, good minerality and acidity with green apple, citrus and cranberries. Certified organic.

Dry and smooth

Domaine de Bel Air, Pouilly-Fumé, Loire, France 2021 58.00
The nose is clean with crisp citrus fruit notes and subtle white flowers. The firm, mineral palate has excellent balance of fine, almost salty acidity with intense lemon, flint and pear flavours and a long finish.

Domaine des Brosses, Sancerre, Loire, France 2022 58.00
A fresh, citrus palate with herbaceous notes of hay and nettle. Richly textured but crisp acidity and textbook minerality. This finish is elegant with the typical purity and refreshment of excellent Sancerre.

Domaine La Soufrandise, Pouilly-Fuissé, Vieilles Vignes, Burgundy, France 2021 63.00
This old-vine Chardonnay has aromas of white nectarine, peach and a subtle hint of tropical fruit on the nose. The minerality shines through on the palate alongside fresh acidity with hints of lemon zest on the long finish.

Montagny, Bouchard Père & Fils, Premier Cru, Cote-D'Or, France 2020 94.00
Delicate aromas of fruit and honey. Lively and aromatic on the palate, the wine reveals an appealing personality.

Pieropan, Soave Classico, Veneto, Italy (organic) 2022 51.00
A fresh and expressive Soave with classic white flower, almond blossom and a touch of citrus. Rounded, ripe fruit is perfectly balanced by a fresh, clean acidity. Long and fragrant. It has a note of almond pastry on the finish.

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Von Winning, Win Win Riesling, Deidesheim, Germany (organic)	2022	51.00
This certified organic wine is sourced from outstanding single-vineyard sites, grown on a combination of red sandstone and limestone. Astoundingly complex, wild yet elegant and produced using spontaneous fermentation in large wooden barrels. Notes of lime, white pepper and faint mandarin peel lead to a long, soft dry finish.		
Dr. Loosen, Riesling, Mosel-Saar-Ruwer, Germany	2018	40.00
Floral nose and palate with just the right harmony of fruit and acidity. Great finish.		
Gašper, Chardonnay/Rebula, Goriška Brda, Slovenia	2021	40.00
Light straw in colour, this is a fresh and fruity wine that displays hints of peach and citrus. A vibrant acidity and lovely roundness, from 5% of the wine being fermented in oak. Gašper is located in Goriška Brda, which is two-thirds of Collio that stretches into Slovenia from Friuli Venezia Giulia on north-eastern Italy. The climate is ideally suited to viticulture.		
Greywacke, Wild Ferment Sauvignon, Marlborough, New Zealand	2022	80.00
Made by legendary winemaker Kevin Judd of Cloudy Bay fame. Spontaneous fermentation with wild yeasts in old French oak barrels gives aromas of summer fruits and pastry. The palate is richly textured with flavours of fleshy stone fruit and lemon, finishing with a dry minerality.		
Ripe and full		
Viognier de Rosine, M & S Ogier D'Ampuis, Northern Rhone, France	2022	103.00
A beautiful, restrained version of this wonderful individual grape variety. Medium-bodied with dramatic aromas of pineapple, apricot and citrus fruits. Wonderful refreshing acidity and it great drunk on it's own or with roast Ballyvolane saddleback pork.		
Viré Clessé, André Bonhomme, Cuvée Spéciale, Mâconnais, Burgundy, France (organic)	2021	57.00
A richly flavoured and textured Chardonnay, certified organic. Ripe green apples, hints of mango and light spices on the nose, followed by a generous and very pure palate where green apples, grapefruit mingle with mangoes and citrus fruits for a long, mineral finish.		
Domaine Bergerie de L'Hortus, Val de Montferrand, Languedoc, France	2022	57.00
Chardonnay, Viognier and Sauvignon Blanc combine to produce something quite magical. There is ripe fruit coming through from the Chardonnay, a crisp backbone of acidity from the Sauvignon and a peachy delicacy from the notoriously difficult Viognier. Vegan friendly.		
Catavela, Denavolo, Giulio Armani, Emilia, Italy (orange) (natural)	NV	49.00
Orange wine is a type of white wine made by leaving the grape skins and seeds in contact with the juice, creating a deep orange-hued finished wine. Light and expressive, with flavours reminiscent of white flowers, beeswax, honey, white fruit and pears, ending with racy minerals.		
Foradori, Fontanasanta Nosiola, Vigneti Delle Dolomiti, Italy (organic) (biodynamic)	2023	69.00
Lovely open apple and pear fruit with a slight lift. Detailed and spicy. Textural with nice citrusy bite. Fermentation with 8 months maceration in amphore, followed by 2 months of ageing in acacia and oak casks. Certified organic by ICEA and Biodynamic by Demeter.
